

Internship USA 2019

FAST FACTS

eligibility

Must be either

- A full-time postsecondary student currently in a nationally accredited institution of higher education (in at least their first year of study when applying for the programme). The applicant must have completed at least one year of study before starting an internship. A minimum age of 18 but no upper age limit.
- A recent graduate from a full-time course is eligible if they begin their internship within 12 months of graduation. Same age restrictions as above.
- Proposed internship must be directly related to the field and level of study.
- Non-New Zealand residents can apply for the programme if they study/have studied at a New Zealand post secondary institution, but may have additional requirements for eligibility placed on them by the US Consulate in New Zealand.

duration

- Work visa lasts for 1-12 months and is issued for the exact dates of internship, as per employer's notification.
- Participants can remain in the USA as tourists for up to 30 days after their work visa expires.

fee including insurance, in US dollars

1-5 Months	\$1615 - 1822
6-9 Months	\$1924 - 2209
10-14 Months	\$2313 - 2693

Fee will be charged in NZ \$ at the exchange rate on the day of application. The US\$ fee rate is consistent but the NZ\$ rate may fluctuate.

additional expenses

- US Consulate visa charges (participants must pay the US Consulate for their visa processing, currently approx NZ\$240.00).

cíee

- If participant earns less than US\$1000 per month, a financial statement is required to show proof of funds to cover the difference. Participants on unpaid internships need to show proof of US\$1000 for each month of the internship.

visa application

- Participants apply for the US J-1 (Exchange Visitor) visa directly at their designated US Consulate after receiving all the necessary documentation, forms and instructions from CIEE and Internship NZ.
- Participants are required to undertake a face to face interview with the US Consulate in Auckland prior to visa approval.
- Participants are advised to apply for this visa in the country of their legal permanent residence.
- Participants with previous J1 internship visas will have to undergo extensive screening to be considered eligible for a further internship on this programme (prior Work and Travel programme participation excluded).

visa conditions

- Participants cannot enter the USA more than 30 days prior to the start of their internship.
- Participants cannot be employed outside of their internship.
- Participants may be able to extend their internship with the same employer if the original sponsorship by CIEE was less than 12 months, to a total of 12 months. An extension fee applies.
- Participants can stay in the USA as tourists for a maximum extra 30 days after the end of their internship.
